

PA STATE CONSTABLE RESUME

During the May, 2015 primary election, I changed my life forever by writing my name in as a candidate on the ballot for the position of Constable. Despite being a write-in candidate with no support from either party, I was elected to the position in the November, 2015 election. Since then, I have served Easttown Township, Chester County as a PA State Constable.

As I understand it, there are two types of PA State Constables: 1) those that only serve on election day to a) keep the peace and b) to ensure the votes are counted properly and; 2) those who, after meeting stringent and multiple certifications, serve the community as law enforcement officers. I have chosen the latter type of commitment. As a constable, I serve for a 6 year term.

To become fully credentialed, I initially had to take and pass an 80-hour Basic Training course, and also pass a 40-hour Basic Firearms course given by the Pennsylvania Commission on Crime and Delinquency (PCCD). Each year, I must take a 20-hour continuing education course and re- certification of my firearms skills.

Constables are considered to be self-employed and are paid for their service by the county that requests the services, with proper invoicing. Constables are also required to purchase their own equipment, insurance, bonds and uniforms from their own funds.

Over the last 5 years as a PA State Constable, I have regularly worked with the Chester County Children and Youth Dept (CCC&Y). In that role, I have been tasked to transport troubled youth from different facilities (eg. lockups/prisons and hospitals) within Pennsylvania, and on, occasion fulfill a need to pickup and transport these teens from locations outside of Pennsylvania. Also, as requested, I have served legal process on defendants in civil ligation matters in Chester County and the surrounding counties.
